The Monday Blues Revue is a Pittsburgh-based band that has been performing their high-energy, eclectic mix of classic and modern blues music in all its forms: Chicago Blues, Texas Blues, Jump Blues, Blues Rock, Rhythm and Blues, Soul, and Southern Rock, since 1997.

Their influences include Santana, Stevie Ray Vaughn, Bill Withers, The Allman Brothers, Jimi Hendrix, Muddy Waters, and anybody that has created music based on America's own unique musical form - the blues.

Chris Monday (drums, vocals) is the namesake of the band and anchors them with a steady beat that keeps your foot moving and your heart thumping. New fans of The Monday Blues Revue come back for more shows just to enjoy Chris's energy.

Tom Altes (bass guitar, vocals) works with Chris to provide the foundation that the band is built on. Tom's genrebending versatility, unique musical background and tastes, and engaging vocal style pull fans into the party.

Dave Baker (harmonica, keyboard, vocals) is a newer member of The Monday Blues Revue and adds a soulful harmonica with stylings that nod to the blues greats of the past like Junior Wells, Sonny Boy Williamson, and Little Walter. When not playing harmonica, you can hear Dave filling in the wall of sound with that classic Hammond B3 sound.

Chrissy Reynolds (congas, timbales, percussion, vocals) is the newest member and adds Latin percussion flavor, rhythmic texture, and inviting vocals that enrich the flavor of The Monday Blues Revue.

Jim Stamps (guitar, bass guitar, vocals) is a veteran of the Pittsburgh music community and brings experience, versatility, and musicianship that is the "special sauce" of The Monday Blues Revue.

Tony Watson (guitar, vocals) started The Monday Blues Revue with his cousin, Chris Monday, upon returning to Pittsburgh from Chicago, where he spent the formative years of his music career studying the history, theory, and practice of the Blues.
